You can sign up for private lessons at the pool once it has opened. It is each person's responsibility to sign up for activities that do not conflict with one another. Most activities require pre-registration. If you need financial assistance for any recreational activity, please contact the City Office at 439-1501. SWIMMING LESSONS

Swimming lessons are again being offered by the Hull Rec. Department under Red Cross supervision. We will have 2 public sessions. The first session will run from June 9 - June 20. The second session will run from July 7 - July 18. Please do not wait until the pool opens to try and schedule your lessons. Once a class reaches 15 kids, it is considered full. If we allow more kids than that in a class, it becomes too many for the instructors to manage and we are not able to give each student the personal attention they need. A bus is available to transport kids from the Boyden area during the first session only. Contact Lori Wolkow at the City of Boyden if you have questions concerning transportation. Boyden participants may attend either session, but transportation is provided by Boyden only during the first session. Each class will run approximately 45 minutes per day. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis and usually limited to about 15 kids. You may turn in your swimming lesson registration anytime before May 20, 2008 by dropping it off at the Hull City Office.

June 23-July 3 and July 21 - August 1 are the dates that will be used for private lessons and bubblebers. Private lessons will be scheduled as time permits, on a first come, first served basis. Each private lesson will be scheduled for 10 classes. Private lessons will be available from 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. in half-hour time increments. These are the only times available for private lessons. A private lesson needs to be scheduled by the guard who will be teaching it. You need to schedule private lessons after the pool opens. The number to the swimming pool is 712-439-2921.

Private Lessons-----	\$65.00 PER STUDENT.

If you have 2 children taking private lessons at the same time, from the same teacher, at the same level, then your fee for both is \$100.00.

We also ask that parents please remain far enough away from the class during lessons, as not to distract the students. Please do not bring other small children along and expect to use the wading pool in the morning. Due to liability reasons, this area will be off limits and locked during lessons. There is a great park nearby for kids to play at while siblings are taking lessons.

Public Lessons must be registered & paid for by May 23, 2008. Private Lessons must be arranged with the lifeguard of your choice, subject to availability, AFTER THE POOL OPENS. Private lessons will be run only during the weeks of June 23-July 3 and July 21-August 1 from 9-11:30AM.

T-Ball

The older groups will have the opportunity to hit without using a tee if they are able. We are going to start doing this in the evenings so more parents can watch their children participate. 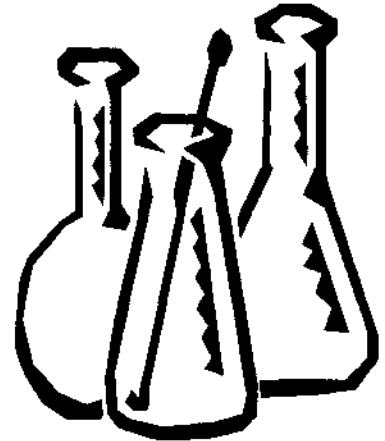

Drive Way Basketball Marking Kit Rentals

The City of Hull has a Basketball Marking kit that can be rented by the day. It has the Basketball Lane and the 3-point line. The kit is the one used to mark the courts at Hubbling Park. You will have to do some of the figuring out of what space you have on your driveway or playground area. You are responsible for marking your driveway. The City will not mark your court for you, but will merely rent the templates out to you so you can make your own court. Cost is \$15 per day. Paint is not included. A security deposit may be required. Stop by the City Office or the Rec Office to reserve it this summer.

Shelter House/Facility Rentals

The City of Hull has several shelter houses available for rent throughout the summer months. Hubbling Park on Main Street has basketball courts, sand volleyball, and many children's activities. The enclosed shelter house in Hubbling Park is only \$15.00 to rent for an evening. The shelter house at Westside Park also has many great activities. It is next door to the pool, and has the Kid's Kingdom playground. It also has a great deal of open space and ball fields. The shelter at Westside Park is divided into 3 sections, costing \$10.00 for each section, or \$30.00 for the entire shelter house. Are YOU Going to Valley Fair or Adventureland this summer?

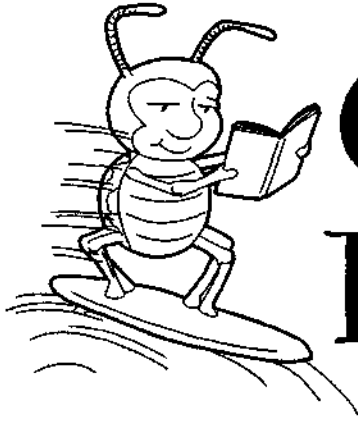

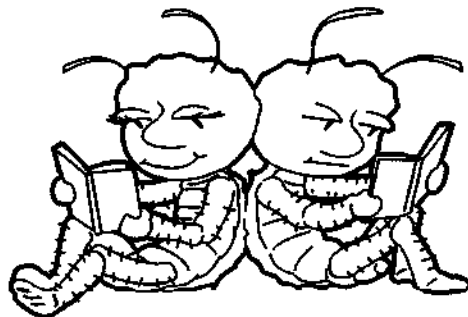
