

City Ordinances

A. All Night Parking

No person, except those on emergency calls, shall park a vehicle on any street for a period of time longer than 30 minutes between the hours of 1:00am and 6:00am of any day during the period from November 1 st to April 1 st,

B. Removal of snow/Cutting of grass

It is the responsibility of a property owner to remove snow and cut grass. If an owner does not remove snow or cut their grass within a reasonable time, the city may do so and assess the cost against the property owner.

C. Dog and Animal Ordinance

\$35.

2. It is unlawful for a person to keep more than two of the following types of animals: dog, cat, ferret, or rabbit.

3. It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow the pet to cause an annoyance or disturbance to any person or persons by frequent habitual howling, yelping, barking, or running/chasing persons, bicycles or other vehicles.

D. Recreational Burning

wood or charcoal. Violators will be prosecuted.

E. Moped rider

All mopeds must have a 4' flag attached to the back of their moped and each moped rider under the age of 18 must wear a helmet (bicycle helmet). Fines will be from \$5.00 to \$35.00.

F. Junk and Junk Vehicles

It is unlawful for any person to store, accumulate or allow to remain on any private property within the city limits any junk or junk vehicle. All vehicles must have an up-to-date license or they will be towed away by the city.
