

General Rules

The registration fee is \$100 per team. To secure your spot in the tournament on **Saturday, January 13th** please send your registration form and fee to the Hull Recreation Department, by **Friday, December 16, 2017**. No spots will be reserved without payment. No refunds will be given if a team cancels. Open to the first 8 teams registered.

Please leave all valuables with parents or coaches. The Hull Rec. Department is not responsible for lost or stolen items. The Hull Rec. Department also assumes no responsibility for accidents or injuries.

We use a pool play to ensure every team of at least 3 games if the tournament is filled. The championship will be determined by a playoff of pool winners. If a tie exists, head to head competition will be used, followed by the best defensive average.

Please remember this is a big day for the kids to have fun and gain some basketball experience. Also remember, everyone working this tournament is a volunteer.

1. NO All-Star Teams
2. All games will consist of 2 - 18 minute halves with a running clock until the last minute of each half. The clock then stops as per normal rules. If needed, overtimes will be 2 minutes long. The clock will stop the last minute of overtime as per normal rules. 2 time-outs per game (30 sec). 1 extra in overtime
3. Halftime will be 3 minutes.
4. 1 and 1 free throws will be used for fouls 7, 8, & 9 of each half with 2 shots being awarded on the 10th and succeeding fouls.
5. All grades will be using the youth/28.5 basketball. Game balls will be provided. You are to bring your own warm up balls.
6. 7th and 8th grade may press up to a 15 point lead. No press in 5th & 6th grade divisions.
7. No zone defenses allowed in the 5th & 6th grade divisions.
8. No 3 pt. field goals allowed in 5th & 6th grade divisions.
9. We will follow the IAHSAA rules concerning technical fouls in that they will count as team fouls and personal fouls. On a technical foul, the opposing team will be awarded 2 points. The accumulation of two technical fouls per individual player or coach for the entire tournament will result in an immediate ejection from the tournament (not just that individual game). Any ejected coach, player, or fan will not be allowed in the gym when his/her team is playing for the remainder of the tournament.
